

## The Fisherman's Advocate, October 29, 1945:

*By Sunday's train there arrived home the last of the Nfld. Regiment from overseas in the person of Lewis Crewe of the 59<sup>th</sup> Regiment Heavy Artillery. Gunner Crewe has been in the forefront of activities since the early days of the Normandy campaign, including the battles of the Caen, the Falaise Gap, through France, on to within a few miles of Berlin and on to Hamberg. His was the experience of witnessing at first hand the terrible conditions, about which the world has been shocked, existing in the notorious concentration Camp at Belsen, Germany. The sights that met their eyes on arrival there were beyond description, the memory of which will remain as long as life itself.....*
